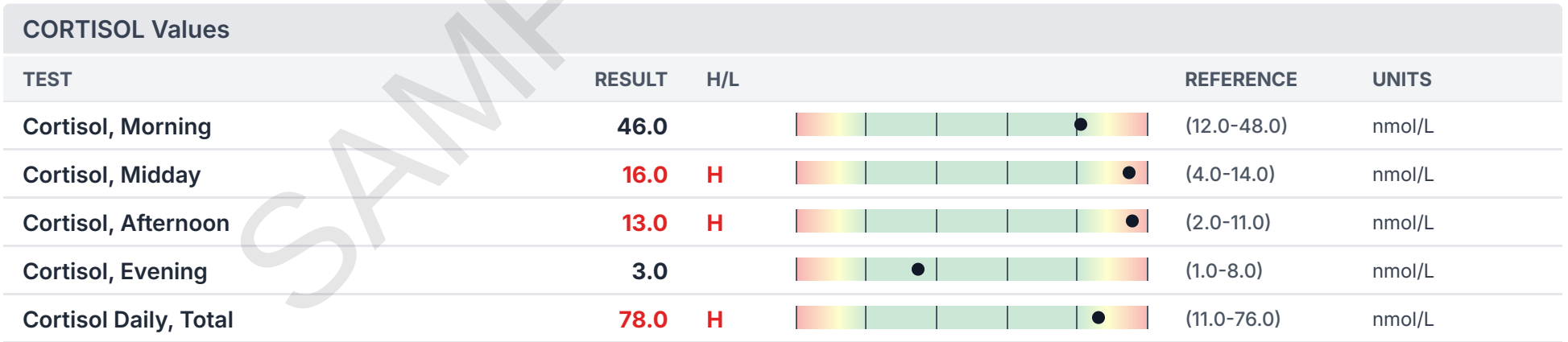
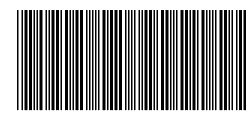

Adrenocortex Stress Comments

MORNING CORTISOL SALIVA LEVEL WITHIN RANGE: Saliva morning cortisol level is adequate and within range.

ELEVATED MIDDAY CORTISOL LEVEL:

Is this due to supplementation, adrenal stress, inflammation, medication or fasting? Suggestive of blood sugar imbalance.

ELEVATED LATE AFTERNOON CORTISOL LEVEL

Is this due to supplementation, adrenal stress, inflammation, medication or fasting? Suggestive of blood sugar imbalance.

SALIVA DHEAs/CORTISOL RATIO - NORMAL:

The ratio of DHEAs to cortisol is normal. This ratio indicates a relative balance of the adrenal output of androgens and cortisol. Both of the hormones are released in response to ACTH from the pituitary and a normal ratio indicates a balanced function of the hypothalamic-pituitary-adrenal axis.
