### GIT Inflammation Comment

FAECAL TRANSGLUTAMINASE IgA: POSITIVE

Tissue Transglutaminase is the most specific test for Coeliac Disease. Levels greater than 100 are deemed as POSITIVE.

Treatment:

Avoid gluten containing foods. Also assess IgG/IgA Food sensitivity tests to identify specific food intolerances.
