NOROVIRUS:

Faecal contamination of ingested foods and water. Common cause of diarrheal (winter vomiting virus-Norwalk) in adults, causing outbreaks on cruise ships/hospitals/nursing homes Symptoms include nausea and vomiting, diarrhoea, abdominal cramps, low-grade fever, muscle aches, fatigue, and headache. Short-lived, lasting about 24-72 hours. Acquired immunity is short-lived. A repeat test for Enteric Viral Pathogens should be requested to ensure that the virus has cleared.

Treatment:

Conservative hygiene measures such as handwashing, Hydration and strict isolation is recommended for cases as such. Other immune modulators that may be beneficial are Vitamins A, C, and D, zinc, Echinacea.
