Description

The 4-Pillar Gut Profile is designed to offer a comprehensive analysis of the gut microbiome using four essential panels. This structured approach provided a thorough assessment for identifying underlying gastrointestinal issues.

Pillar 1: Complete Microbiome Mapping

This test utilises quantitative PCR (qPCR) technology to screen for a wide array of microorganisms, including bacteria, viruses, fungi, parasites, and worms (Sezgin et al., 2022). This panel also includes a broad range of gastrointestinal functional markers for a more in-depth assessment.

Pillar 2: IgG96 Food Sensitivity Testing

This panel is particularly useful for individuals who suspect food sensitivities may be causing symptoms but are unable to identify which ones. The presence of IgG antibodies in the bloodstream suggests an immune response to specific foods and can help identify offending foods (Vita et al., 2022).

Pillar 3: Intestinal Permeability

Commonly referred to as a "leaky gut" assessment, this test evaluates the gut lining's integrity. It helps determine nutrient absorption issues related to an imbalanced microbiome or food intolerances (Di Vincenzo et al., 2024).

Pillar 4: SIBO Lactulose Breath Test

This breath test assesses Small Intestinal Bacterial Overgrowth (SIBO) by measuring the gases (hydrogen and methane) produced when bacteria in the small intestine ferment lactulose. These gases can indicate bacterial overgrowth, which may cause symptoms like bloating, gas, and digestive discomfort (Rezaie et al., 2017).
