Description

The Worm and Helminth Screen is used to detect the presence of parasitic worms or helminths in an individual's body. Helminths are multicellular parasitic worms that can invade various organs and tissues, potentially leading to a range of health complications (Strunz et al., 2016). Infections caused by these parasites are referred to as helminthiasis (Strunz et al., 2016).

The symptoms associated with helminth infections vary according to the type of worm and the organs or systems affected. Common manifestations may include gastrointestinal disturbances, abdominal pain, diarrhea, weight loss, and fatigue (Strunz et al., 2016). Some individuals may also experience more severe complications, such as malnutrition or intestinal blockages, depending on the extent and nature of the infection.

A worm and helminths screen may be conducted when a healthcare professional suspects an infection based on the patient's symptoms, medical history, or known exposure to risk factors such as travel to areas where these parasites are prevalent (Strunz et al., 2016). Early detection and treatment of helminth infections are crucial for preventing complications and improving the overall health of affected individuals.
